Arrested in Spain four jihadist recruiters

USPA NEWS - The Central Court of Instruction, Number 1, and the Attorney of the Spanish National Court has directed an antiterrorist operation in which Civil Guard have arrested four people in different parts of Spain. Two in Melilla and the other two in the provinces of Barcelona and Girona.

The two arrested in Melilla are responsible for the creation and administration of various Internet platforms through which spreading all kinds of propaganda material of terrorist groups, especially known as DAESH. This material was edited and translated into Spanish by detainees, to reach more people. Building on the successful marketing of the virtual platform, made apology for terrorist tactics, with particular emphasis on the act of martyrdom. Both men, who were aligned with the strategy of the terrorist group DAESH, were dedicated to the recruitment of women who, after due process of indoctrination, just integrated into this terrorist group.

In addition, recruitment activities were not limited to the virtual environment, but the two men made use of private meetings in homes where showed, Muslims captured potential, the most current and media videos DAESH in order to indoctrinate them to, eventually incorporate the aforementioned terrorist group in conflict zones. Some of these young people already have begun prior to the move to areas of activities of terrorist groups preparations.

The Civil Guard investigates the connections of the two people arrested in Catalonia with those arrested in Melilla. The arrests were made in the provinces of Barcelona and Girona. The two men developed a strong pro-jihadist autonomous activity and, in turn, interact on Facebook administered from Melilla. In this case, the profile of the two men is different from each other, since one of them corresponds to that of a facilitator who edited the video and spread prolifically graphic designed to recruit new jihadists material and the other corresponds to a prototypical profile solo actor, ie had spent consuming filoterrorista propaganda during intense proselytizing same characteristics.
